TOWNSHIP OF EVESHAM

ORDINANCE 5-1-98

**AMENDING THE CODE OF
THE TOWNSHIP OF EVESHAM
CHAPTER 67, ENTITLED:
"DOGS"**

BE IT ORDAINED by the Township Council of the Township of Evesham, County of Burlington, State of New Jersey that Chapter 67 of the Township Code be and is hereby amended as follows:

Section 1. The new title for §67-5. shall be:

"General regulations; nuisances; barking."

Section 2. §67-5.C. of the Code of the Township of Evesham, is hereby amended in its entirety, as follows:

§67-5. General regulations; nuisances; barking.

- C. No person shall own, keep or harbor a dog or other domestic animal which habitually barks, howls, cries or makes other noises for more than any one (1) hour or continuous barking and howling for periods of less than one (1) hour but more than one-half (1/2) hour, which periods occur on two (2) or more consecutive days, whether during the day or night. No person shall own more than one (1) dog or other domestic animal which, as a collective group, habitually bark, cry, howl or make other noise for more than any one (1) hour or continuous barking and howling for periods of less than one (1) hour but more than one-half (1/2) hour, whether during the day or night. Nothing in this section shall prohibit the normal and occasional barks, cries, howls or other noises associated with any one (1) such domestic animal.

Section 3. All ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent with this ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.

Section 4. If any section, paragraph, subdivision, clause or provision of this ordinance shall be adjudged invalid, such adjudication shall apply only to the section, paragraph, subdivision, clause or provision and the remainder of this ordinance shall be deemed valid and effective.

Section 5. This Ordinance shall take effect immediately after final passage and publication as required by law.
