

BOROUGH OF MANASQUAN  
ORDINANCE NO. 1823-00

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND SECTION 47-6 (DOGS RESTRICTED) OF CHAPTER 47 (BEACHFRONT USE AND REGULATIONS) OF THE CODE OF THE BOROUGH OF MANASQUAN TO ESTABLISH REGULATIONS AND TIMES AT WHICH DOGS ARE PERMITTED ON THE MUNICIPAL BEACHFRONT.

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Borough Council of the Borough of Manasquan, in the County of Monmouth and State of New Jersey, as follows:

Section 1 Section 47-6 (Dogs Restricted) of Chapter 47 (Beachfront Use and Regulations) of the Code of the Borough of Manasquan is amended as follows:

It shall be unlawful for the owner of any dog to permit same to be upon the dedicated beachfront, beachwalk or municipal property adjacent thereto between April 1<sup>st</sup> and October 31<sup>st</sup> of each year.

The owner of any dog under the control of a leash may utilize the dedicated beachfront east of the sand dunes, and the approaches and beachwalk for access only, between November 1<sup>st</sup> and March 31<sup>st</sup> of each year.

Section 2. If any part or parts of this Ordinance are for any reason held to be invalid, such adjudication shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions of this Ordinance.

Section 3. All ordinances or parts of Ordinances which are inconsistent herewith are repealed, but only to the extent of such inconsistency. All other parts of Chapter 47 not inconsistent herewith are ratified and confirmed.

Section 4. This Ordinance shall become effective immediately upon its final passage and publication as required by law.
