

TOWNSHIP OF EVESHAM

ORDINANCE 22-6-2000

AMENDING THE CODE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF EVESHAM TO CREATE CHAPTER 70 "DRUNK-DRIVING FREE SCHOOL ZONES"

WHEREAS, the Township Council of the Township of Evesham considers the safety of the Township's children a paramount concern; and

WHEREAS, the Township Code of the Township of Evesham, Chapter 69, adopted Drug-Free School Zone Maps, amended from time to time to reflect changes in boundaries.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Township Council of the Township of Evesham, County of Burlington, State of New Jersey, as follows:

Section One. The Code of the Township Evesham is hereby amended to create Chapter 70 entitled: "Drunk-Driving Free School Zones" to read as follows:

§70-1. Designation of School Crossings.

In accordance with and pursuant to the authority of P.L. 1999 Ch. 185, the following is a list of school crossings which have been so designated by the Township of Evesham:

Tomahawk Drive & Munger Avenue
Arrowhead Drive & Schoolhouse Lane
Caldwell Avenue & Bancroft Road
Caldwell Avenue & Radnor Boulevard (Heritage)
Knox Boulevard & Marlborough Avenue
Willowbend Road & Kevin Way
Wescott Road & Jaggard School
Willowbend Road & Kenton Avenue
Conestoga Drive & Revere Road
Greentree Road & Charter Oak Drive
Greentree Road & Conestoga Drive
Conestoga Drive & Bartram Road
Crown Royal Parkway & Rice School
Carlton Avenue & Wellington Drive
Carlton Avenue & Palmetto Avenue
Carlton Avenue & Bon Air Drive

§70-2. Adoption of Map.

In accordance with and pursuant to the authority of P.L. 1988, c. 44 (2C:35-7), P.L. 1997, c. 327 (N.J.S.A. 2C:35-7.1), and P.L. 1999, c. 185, Free School Zone Map produced by Richard A. Alaimo Associates, Engineers, as amended from time to time, is hereby approved and adopted as finding and record of the location and areas within the municipality of real property which is used for school purposes, which is designated as a school crossing owned or leased to an elementary or secondary school or school board, on section and of the areas on or within one thousand (1,000) feet of such property.

§70-3. Original Map and List to be on File: Copies.

The Township Clerk is hereby directed to receive and to keep on file the original of the map approved and adopted pursuant to §70-2 of this chapter and the list of school crossings and to provide at a reasonable cost a true copy of the map approved and adopted herein and kept on file. It is hereby further directed that a true copy of the map and list shall be provided without cost to the Burlington County Clerk and to the Burlington County Prosecutor.

§70-4. Map and List as Evidence.

The following additional matters are hereby determined, declared, resolved and stated:

It is understood that the map and list approved and adopted pursuant to this chapter was prepared and is intended to be used as evidence in prosecution under the criminal and traffic laws of this state and that, pursuant to state law, the map and list shall constitute prima facie evidence of the following:

- (1) The location of elementary and secondary schools within the municipality.
- (2) The boundaries of the real property which is owned by or leased to elementary schools or a school board.
- (3) That such school property is and continues to be used for school purposes.

Section Two. If any section, paragraph, subdivision, clause or provision of this ordinance shall be adjudged invalid, such adjudication shall apply only to the section, paragraph, subdivision, clause or provision and the remainder of this ordinance shall be deemed to remain in full force and effect.

Section Three. This Ordinance shall take effect immediately following final adoption and publication according to law.
