RESOLUTION \* 2-34. 1998

RE: RESOLUTION APPROVING A MAP PREPARED BY THE  
BOROUGH ENGINEER AS AN OFFICIAL FINDING AND  
RECORD OF THE LOCATION AND BOUNDARIES OF THE  
AREA OR AREAS ON OR WITHIN 500 FEET OF PUBLIC  
HOUSING FACILITIES, PUBLIC PARKS, AND/OR  
PUBLIC BUILDINGS WITHIN THE BOROUGH OF  
WOODDINE, AS THOSE PUBLIC PROPERTIES ARE  
DEFINED BY N.J.S.A. 2C:35-7.1.

WHEREAS, pursuant to N.J.S.A. 2C:35-7.1, there is an enhanced criminal penalty for a person who violates N.J.S.A. 2C:35-7.1 (hereinafter referred to as the "Act") by distributing, dispensing or possessing with intent to distribute a controlled dangerous substance or controlled substance analogue while in, or within 500 feet of the real property comprising a public housing facility, a public park, or a public building; and

WHEREAS, the Act defines "public housing facility" as any dwelling, complex of dwellings, accommodation, building, structure or facility and real property of any nature appurtenant thereto and used in connection therewith, which is owned by or leased to a local housing authority in accordance with the "Local Redevelopment and Housing Law" for the purpose of providing living accommodations to persons of low income; and

WHEREAS, the Act defines "public park" as a park, recreation facility or area, or playground owned or controlled by a State, county or local government unit; and

WHEREAS, the Act defines "public building" as any publicly owned or leased library or museum; and

WHEREAS, the Borough Engineer has prepared a map of those properties in the Borough of Woodbine, coming within the definitions aforesaid, of such areas within 500 feet of such public properties as defined in the Act; and

WHEREAS, in accordance with the Act, the map shall be filed with the Clerk of the Borough of Woodbine and maintained as an official record of the Borough.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Woodbine, in the County of Cape May and State of New Jersey as follows:

1. The statements in the preamble are incorporated herein by this reference.

2. The aforesaid map, as prepared by the Borough Engineer of Woodbine, be and the same is hereby approved as an official finding and record of the location and boundaries of the area or areas on or within 500 feet of public housing facilities, public parks and/or public buildings within the Borough of Woodbine, within the definitions of same provided by N.J.S.A. 2C:35-7.1.

3. The original of said *map* shall be filed with the Clerk of the Borough of Woodbine and maintained as an official record of the Borough.
