


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the governing body of the Township of Lacey, County of Ocean, State of New Jersey, as follows:

1. That the Mayor and Township Committee do hereby authorize the Tax Collector's Office to accept credit card payments for the payment of municipal tax bills.
2. That the Mayor and Township Committee authorize the Municipal Court Office to accept credit card payments for the payment of municipal court fees, fines, and such other payments that may be due to the municipal court. The Mayor and Township Committee do further authorize the Police Department to accept credit card payment of bail and such other payments that are to be made to the Municipal Court as the Police Department is authorized to accept.
3. That the use of credit cards for payment is subject to the provisions of N.J.A.C. 5:30-9.1 et seq. In regard to the Municipal Court and the Police Department, where the Police Department is accepting payments required by the Municipal Court, these payments are subject to the provisions of N.J.A.C. 5:30-9.1 as well as the Rules of Court adopted by the New Jersey Supreme Court, and such guidelines as the Supreme Court may adopt in regard to the acceptance of credit card payments for municipal court obligations.
