

**ORDINANCE NO. 2004-17**  
**ADOPTED JUNE 23, 2004**  
**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 61 (ANIMALS),**  
**BY AMENDING ARTICLE I, REGULATING**  
**AND LICENSING OF DOGS**

**BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWNSHIP COMMITTEE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF MANALAPAN, COUNTY OF MONMOUTH, NEW JERSEY** as follows:

I.

Chapter 61, Animals, ARTICLE I, Regulating and Licensing of Dogs, Section 61-18, Regulation and Control, of the Manalapan Code is amended as follows (additions are underlined, deletions are in [brackets]):

E. Running at large. No person owning, keeping or harboring any dog shall suffer to permit it to run at large outside the premises of the owner unless (1) The dog is restrained by a fence, enclosure or leash or (2) an electronic fence has been installed on the property and an individual at least twelve (12) years of age is present [at all times] on the premises at all times the dog remains outside.

II.

**REPEAL OF CONFLICTING ORDINANCES**

Any Ordinances of the Township which are in conflict with this Ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.

III.

**SEVERABILITY**

If any part of this Ordinance shall be deemed invalid, such parts shall be severed and the invalidity thereof shall not effect the remaining parts of this Ordinance.

IV.

**EFFECTIVE DATE**

This Ordinance shall take effect upon final adoption and publication in according to law.
