

ORDINANCE 97:4

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 68, STRATFORD CODE, LICENSING
HAWKERS, PEDDLERS, CANVASSERS AND SOLICITORS IN THE
BOROUGH OF STRATFORD

BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and Stratford Borough Council of the Borough of Stratford, County of Camden, State of New Jersey, to amend Chapter 68, Section 8, "Badges", to read as follows.'

68-8 Badges.

At the same time that the license is issued by the Chief of Police, the licensee shall also be given a badge containing the words "Licensed Solicitor" or "Licensed Vendor." If the licensee is a partnership or corporation and has one (1) or more employees or representatives, or an individual having employees or representatives, who are to participate in the business or activity for which a license has been issued, then a badge shall be issued for each of such persons or individuals as well as a duplicate copy of such license for each of them, which copy or copies shall be serially numbered. In order to obtain such badges, such licensee, in addition to the license fee, shall leave a deposit with the Chief of Police in the sum of ten dollars (\$10.00) for each badge.
