ORDINANCE 04-09

ORDINANCE IN ACCORDANCE WITH N.J.S. 40:52-7 AUTHORIZING A LICENSE AND ESTABLISHING THE ASSOCIATE FEE FOR GIS DATA (GEOGRAPHIC INFORMATION SYSTEM)

WHEREAS, the Township of East Brunswick through the Planning and Engineering Department has developed a Geographic Information System (GIS) consisting of mapping and data base which contains information on parcels of property throughout the municipality; and

WHEREAS, said information is of value to regulated utilities, non profit organizations and private enterprise when making capital improvements or physical modifications to their property located within the political boundaries of East Brunswick; and

WHEREAS, the sharing of GIS Data through a license agreement with various parties assists the Township, in its planning and application review process, provides public safety to the residents of the community and reduces municipal costs.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED by the Township Council, Township of East Brunswick, County of Middlesex, State of New Jersey according to the following:

SECTION 1. The Township has developed a Geographic Information System (GIS) which consists of mapping and data base calculation showing information on parcels of property, public improvements, utility lines and storm water drainage facilities within the Township and said intellectual property has a residual value which could be licensed to specific individuals or corporations to help maintain and guarantee the health, safety, and public welfare of the community.

SECTION 2. Said licensing of the GIS Data System shall be limited to a period of not greater than ten (10) years subject to an annual maintenance fee.

SECTION 3. The fee for the license agreement shall be based upon the number of parcels of property involved as it relates to the total GIS System and said calculation shall be performed by the Engineering Department subject to concurrence by the CFO and filed for each application with the Municipal Clerk.

SECTION 4. The licensing application shall be subject to an annual maintenance fee after the anniversary date of the initial license fee granted by the Engineering Division.

SECTIONS 5. If any section, paragraph, subdivision, clause or provision of the Ordinance shall be adjudged invalid, such adjudication shall apply only to the section, paragraph, subdivision, clause or provision so adjudged and the remainder of the Ordinance shall be deemed valid and effective.

SECTION 6. All ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent with or in conflict with the Ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.

SECTION 7. This Ordinance shall take effect twenty (20) days after final passage, adoption and publication according to law.
