

BOROUGH OF MANASQUAN
ORDINANCE NO. 1793 -99

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 107 (ZONING)
OF THE CODE OF THE BOROUGH OF MANASQUAN
TO DEFINE THE TERM PRIVATE SWIMMING POOL IN
AND BY THE BOROUGH OF MANASQUAN,
MONMOUTH COUNTY, NEW JERSEY.

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Borough Council of the Borough of Manasquan, in
the County of Monmouth and State of New Jersey, as follows:

Section Subsection "B" of Section 107-3 (Definitions and Word Usage) of
Chapter 107 (Zoning) of the Code of the Borough of Manasquan is amended as
follows:

SWIMMING POOL, PRIVATE – Any artificially manufactured or
constructed swimming pool or tank permanently or temporarily
established or maintained upon any premises by any individual for
his own or his family's use or the use of guests of his household,
which has a capacity for a water depth of more than twelve (12)
inches, whether maintained above or below ground level.

Section 2. If any part or parts of this Ordinance are for any reason held to be
invalid, such adjudication shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions of this
ordinance.


Section 3. All Ordinances or parts of Ordinances which are inconsistent
herewith are repealed, but only to the extent of such inconsistency. All other parts of
Chapter 107 of the Code of the Borough of Manasquan not inconsistent herewith are
ratified and confirmed.

Section 4. This Ordinance shall become effective immediately upon its final
passage and publication as required by law.
