Ordinance No. 2003-23

AN ORDINANCE TO SUPPLEMENT CHAPTER 204 OF THE MUNICIPAL CODE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF MANALAPAN TO PROVIDE FOR REGULATIONS GOVERNING THE REMOVAL OF SNOW AND ICE IN THE TOWNSHIP

WHEREAS property owners when clearing accumulated snow from the driveways and sidewalks have been observed throwing or placing the snow in the street right of way after the street right of way has been cleared by the Township; and

WHEREAS this placement of accumulated snow in the right of way results in hazardous conditions on the public street since the Township may not return to re-plow the street in a timely manner.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWNSHIP COMMITTEE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF MANALAPAN IN THE COUNTY OF MONMOUTH, STATE OF NEW JERSEY that Chapter 204, Streets and Sidewalks, of the Municipal Code of the Township is supplemented by the following:

ARTICLE III: Casting of Snow and Ice

No owner, tenant or occupant of any premises abutting any street, nor any person working for or on behalf of any owner, tenant or occupant, shall throw, place or deposit any snow or ice upon the public street in front of their property. The intent of this section is to prohibit all persons from throwing, placing or depositing snow or ice from the private driveway, parking area, or on the sidewalk in front of the property, upon the municipal street or sidewalks of the township.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that any person who violates any provision of this article shall, upon conviction thereof, be punishable by any combination of the following: a fine not exceeding \$1,000, imprisonment for a term not exceeding 90 days or a period of community service not exceeding 90 days.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED this ordinance shall take effect upon the final adoption as required by law.
