

Chapter 2 **S-727** **02/06/2017**

“New Jersey Open Data Initiative;” to require certain information be provided on Internet to public and State agencies.

Chapter 3 **S-879** **02/06/2017**

Prohibits termination of law enforcement officer or firefighter based upon determination that officer or firefighter is physically unable to perform duty under certain circumstances.

Chapter 7 **S-1830** **02/06/2017**

Requires DOH regulations regarding elevated blood lead levels in children, and appropriate responses thereto, to be consistent with latest Center for Disease Control and Prevention recommendations.

Chapter 13 **S-2731** **02/06/2017**

Authorizes New Jersey Environmental Infrastructure Trust to expend additional sums to make loans for environmental infrastructure projects for FY2017.

Chapter 14 **S-2732** **02/06/2017**

Amends list of environmental infrastructure projects approved for long-term funding for FY 2017 to include new projects and revise allowable loan amounts for already approved projects.

Chapter 15 **A-333** **02/10/2017**

Ensures project deadline fairness, enhances transparency, and establishes foreclosure protection and mortgage relief program for Superstorm Sandy – impacted victims.

Chapter 16 **A-544** **02/10/2017**

Requires annual notice of assessment on property to contain bolded notice of filing deadline for appeal.

Chapter 19 **A-2199** **02/10/2017**

Establishes veterans’ preference for affordable housing in certain housing projects.

Chapter 21 **A-2514** **02/10/2017**

Permits local units of government to enter into shared services agreements with federal military installations located in the State.

Chapter 26 **A-3695** **02/10/2017**

Regulates transportation network companies.

Chapter 27 **A-3696** **02/10/2017**

Eliminates sales and use tax on certain transportation services provided by a limousine operator.

Chapter 28 **S-3** **02/10/2017**

Requires health insurance coverage for treatment of substance use disorders; places certain restrictions on the prescription of opioid and certain other drugs; concerns continuing education related thereto.
