1. League New Website Announcement

2. Vegetative Waste Management

Spring cleanup and the damaging March storms may present challenges for managing municipal vegetative waste. DEP advises vegetative debris can be stored at temporary debris management areas, or TDMA's. TDMA's can be used for winter storms and/or tropical storm/hurricane events. Information and applications on DEP approval for a TDMA
