Nominations are now being accepted for the Mayors Hall of Fame. The Mayors' Hall of Fame was rolled out on November 15, 1995, at the Mayors' Luncheon during the 80th Annual League Conference in Atlantic City. There are three recognition levels: Silver (10 Years), Gold (20 Years), and White (30 Years). Mayors who are currently serving and have served a total of 10, 20, or 30 years as mayor are eligible for nomination by associates or for themselves.
